



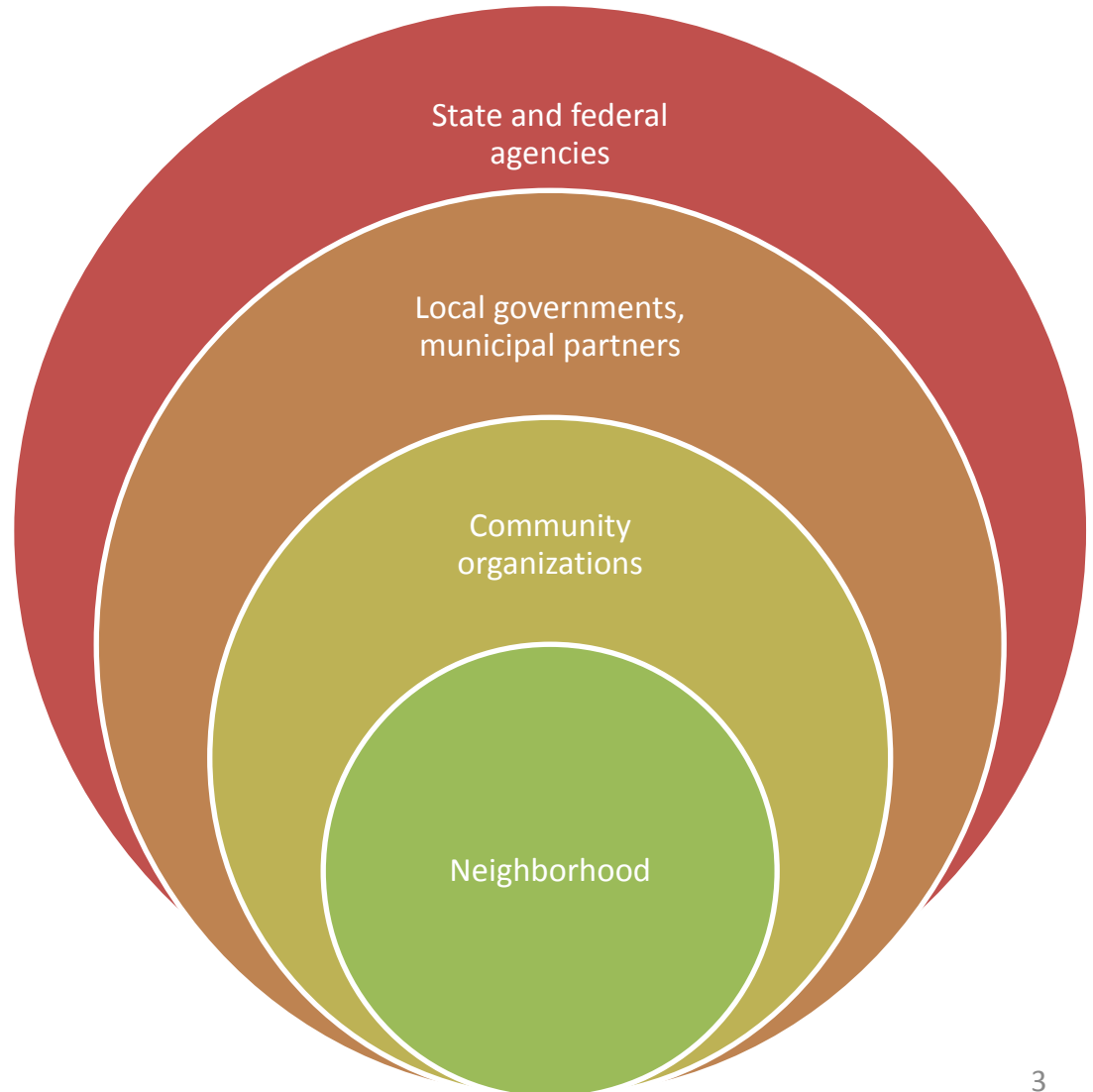
NYS Community, Opportunity, Reinvestment (CORe) Initiative





Goals of CORe

- **Align** programs, policies and funding across government agencies – both vertically (state-and-local) and horizontal (all state agencies) – to address common challenges;
- **Target** our efforts and investments based on the places and people the data show are linked to concentrations of distress; and
- **Evaluate** whether our interventions are achieving the intended results based on agreed-to metrics, and make changes when necessary.





The CORe Solution

- Combines local planning and coordination with active state engagement to deconstruct previously-siloed agencies and holistically address community need.
- Coordinates multiple initiatives in the targeted specific neighborhoods and seeks to leverage existing resources for greater impact, and build the capacity of communities and empower local residents.



The CORe Solution includes:

- Monthly local meetings to take action on key initiatives and identify barriers to success
- Monthly state-level meetings with key decision makers to address barriers and how to better align programs for success
- Targeted, promising and innovative interventions rapidly implemented to address local indicators of distress
- Local special projects to engage residents and build community capacity

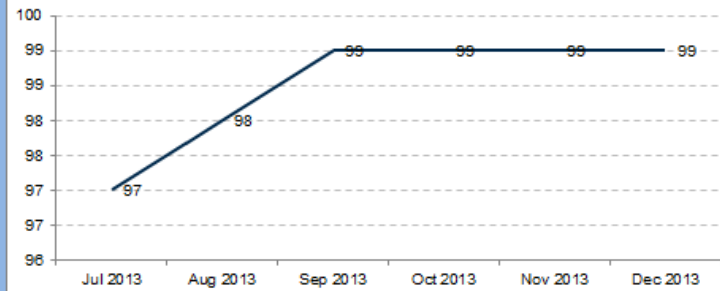
- Comprehensive tool for measuring current and future well-being to better structure future policy and programs

- An integrative dashboard tool that will be updated and reviewed monthly to evaluate progress to addressing key indicators of distress.



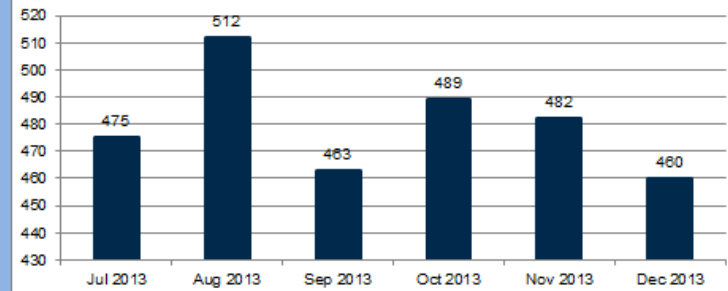
Housing 360° View (Albany)



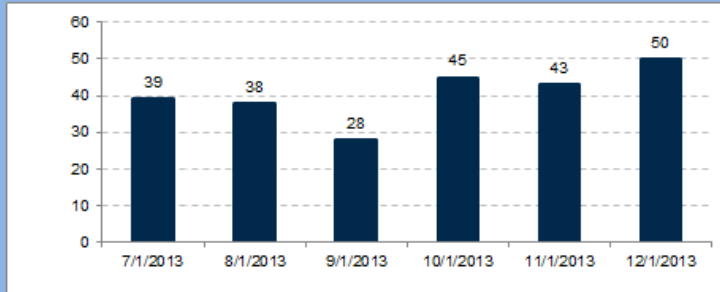
Active Vacant Buildings (Arbor Hill)



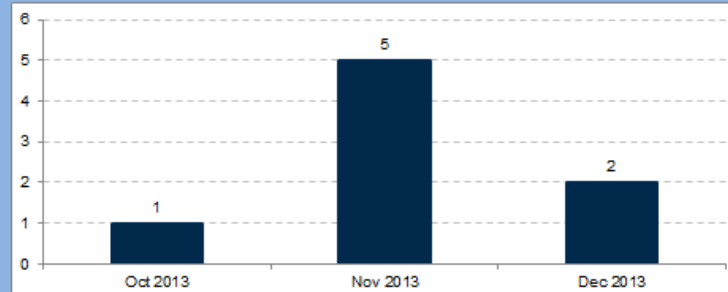
of Sheltered Homeless People (Albany City)



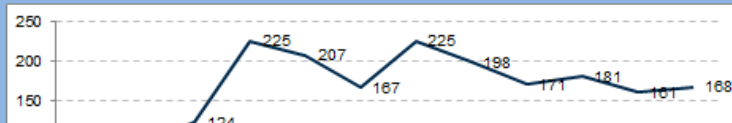
of Sheltered Homeless People (South End)
